## ***Professional Resources For You....***

NSEA distributes a **newsletter "NSEA News"** to NSEA members bi-weekly via email. In addition periodically publishes **The Journal of Student Employment** and is beginning work on the Third Edition of **The Work Book** . Members also benefit from an on-line membership directory, as well as news updates and other low-cost publications of professional interest.

At the **annual conference**, members become informed about the latest trends in the field, enjoy fellowship with colleagues, and share resources, samples and ideas.

At NSEA-sponsored **training seminars**, professionals study legal issues pertinent to student employment, review specifics of interviewing, selection and placement, learn techniques for supervisor and student training and enjoy in-depth discussion of Federal Work-Study and the Job Location and Development Program.

Corporate members have **access** to student employment professionals across the nation who can disseminate information about job and training opportunities, scholarships, programs, and other benefits useful in recruiting and retaining student workers for part-time and career-related positions.

**Professional development opportunities** are available through committee assignments, special projects and leadership positions.

**Research funding** is available to members interested in conducting surveys or other research projects of general interest to the membership.

NSEA offers members an excellent medium to keep abreast of new developments and techniques for implementation of the latest Federal programs, such as **Federal Community Service Work-Study and literacy programs**.

**Electronic networking** through NSEA's student employment listserv allows members to get instant feedback on issues, practices and questions.

### **Student Employment Essentials Training**

Student Employment Essentials (SEE) are two, one-day, student employment professional seminars that teach you critical success skills as well as the “essentials” to run your university’s student employment program.

### **Student Employee of the Year**

The **National Student Employee of the Year** competition, designed to raise public awareness of the importance of student employment, is held each spring. NSEA sponsors National Student Employment Week, which has received presidential endorsement as a special week to honor student workers across the country.

### **A Voice in Washington**

Our Federal Relations Committee works with House and Senate committees to discuss and improve various aspects of Federal Work-Study, Job Location and Development, community service, minimum wage legislation, negotiated rule-making and re-authorization.
